1 **Q. Please state your name, occupation, and business address.**

2 A. My name is Patrick M. Flaherty and I presently serve as the Senior Director of
3 Fab 9 and Fab 10 Site Operations for GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. 2 LLC
4 (“GLOBALFOUNDRIES”). My business address is 2070 Route 52, Hopewell

11 between Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) and GLOBALFOUNDRIES that was
12 filed with the Commission on September 11, 2018.

13 **Q. What is the purpose of your testimony?**

14 A. I offer testimony in support of the proposed Term Contract between GMP and
15 GLOBALFOUNDRIES, which was submitted to the Commission for approval
16 pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 229 on September 11, 2018, and to sponsor my testimony
17 and exhibits from that proceeding as **Exhibit GF-PF-1**. That testimony describes
18 the intense competitive pressures that GLOBALFOUNDRIES’ Vermont facility
19 faces, and the urgent need to have stable, predictable, and lower energy costs to
20 allow GLOBALFOUNDRIES to continue to maintain its operations in Vermont.
21 It also explains how the Term Contract with GMP will help meet these needs and
22 resolve issues related to GMP’s open rate dockets, including this one.
